

MGP Caliper Covers Installation Guide

*Before starting, ensure that the front and rear clips remain separate as they are different. Measure the distance between the back of your wheel and the front of the caliper, you will need 1/8 inch of clearance.



Tools Required for Installation

- 3/8" Wrench
- .013 Feeler Gauge (optional)
- Pliers
- Jack
- Tire Chock
- Lug wrench/ Torque Wrench

Note: Some brake pads have wire clips from the factory. This clip interferes with the Caliper Cover and pushes it closer to wheel. Use pliers to flatten the clip and a straight edge to ensure the clips do not protrude past the front of the caliper.

Clip Design #1 Procedure

1. Place Caliper Cover in place. Note: Caliper Cover attaches to the caliper bracket as shown.



Bridge should rest on caliper bracket

2. Slid clip into place. Fasten caliper cover to caliper bracket. Note: Clip is bendable, bend to make snug fit as needed.



Slide clip onto caliper bridge and under bracket between brake pads as shown.

Bend clip in or out for adjustment to fit as needed.



Clip Design #2 Procedure

1. Place the rear clips into position on the caliper.



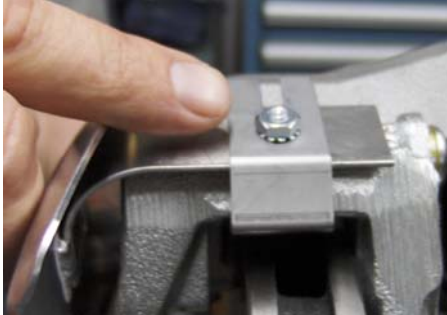
2. Fit the cover onto the clip posts and tighten nuts as shown in step 5.

3. Install nut and tighten lightly to a “snug” pressure with finger tips. No need to over tighten.



4. Tighten with a 3/8” wrench about a ¼ Turn or torque at 25 inch pounds. **Do not over tighten.**



5. Use a feeler gauge, you need .013 clearance between the clip and rotor.

6. Re-install Wheel. Rotate the wheel to check no rubbing is occurring prior to lowering the wheel. Lower the jack and fully tighten lug nuts per Manufacturers recommendations.

Guaranteed Fit for listed models, we just ask you install your covers within 30 days of your purchase.
